- What do you need to be able to do in order to meet the need you previously identified?

- GOAL is being met/strived toward
- Action-based community engagement
- Reflection and vision moving forward
- Look back the entirety of the experience
- Reflect on the fruit of the work that was done, both inwardly and on the community
- Put tangible steps in place to apply the experience to both vocation and daily life
